- Anyone is welcome to fly in Friday afternoon and camp overnight. Bring your own camp gear and food. We will be there and have a bonfire Friday night!
- Bring your own tie downs.
- Propwash Ranch's runways are located 1.5 miles east of Flying J (E37).
- 32.848674, -109.849709
- We are not on the charts... YET.
- We have a short North-South runway that will be used for parking planes.
- Please land on the longer East-West runway.
- Safford Airport (KSAD) has self-serve fuel and is 12 miles away.
- We will be using frequency 122.9
- Our runway is dirt, 2,500' x 50', sloping 1.5 degrees upward to the West. There is a 110' hill off the West end of the runway. It is easy to turn to the North into descending terrain if the hill can't be cleared on takeoff.
- This is a slightly more challenging strip than most paved runways, however most general aviation aircraft should have no problem.
