Scholarship Program Overview

- Scholarships are a key focus for the APA to ensure support for the next generation of Arizona aviation professionals
- Scholarships assist young men and women from Arizona in achieving a vocational or post-secondary education school education
- A wide range of aviation related fields are eligible for scholarship awards
 - Professional Pilot
 - Airframe & Powerplant (A&P)/Maintenance
 - Air Traffic Control
 - Airport Operations/Management
- APA awards 6 – 8 scholarships annually (~ \$2,500 ea.) to help fill the unmet financial need of students pursuing aviation-related education opportunities at accredited colleges, universities, and flight schools

How to Apply

- Open Scholarship Application link
- Complete application and upload required documents:
 - Copy of current school transcript
 - Cover letter indicating why you are interested and any related information (one page maximum)
 - Recommendation letter(s) from teachers, employers, etc. (required)
- **Application deadline: 31 October 2021**
